- natural resource management
- pest control, biosecurity and emergency management
- sustainable land management.

"These two days are a fantastic opportunity for landholders and community members to have a casual chat with us and learn more about the services and support we can provide," Senior Land Services Officer, Kaye Gottschutzke said.

"It is also a great opportunity for us to catch up with landholders and community members we have worked with in recent years and see how their projects are going, as well as give them the opportunity to update us on other opportunities or issues in their local area."
